

Confirmation at Renewal Presbyterian Church

Children who are non-communing members at Renewal Presbyterian Church will often come to a point in their maturity and walk with Jesus where they are ready to publicly confess their faith in Christ and begin receiving the Lord's Supper with the rest of the covenant community. There is no specific age limit for this to happen and parents are likely in the best position to help the child determine if the time is right for them to consider this next important step in their lives.

Confirmation Class

Renewal will offer, on an as-needed basis, a Confirmation Class for those non-communing children and teens who are considering becoming a communing member of the church. This class is designed to go through the catechism in an age-appropriate way. After the non-communing members complete the class, they will be given the opportunity to meet with an elder or pastor to confess and demonstrate their faith.

This will coincide with the times of the year we offer new member installation Sundays. The exact dates and times these classes will be offered will depend on the number, age, and availability of the non-communing members and their families.
