

PHILADELPHIA RENEWAL NETWORK INTAKE PROCESS

This outlines the PRN intake process for those who would like to partake in the benefits of Renewal's association with PRN. You may seek PRN services independently without a Renewal association, but certain information and benefits (spiritual and financial) outlined here may not apply. If seeking PRN services as an extension of pastoral care at Renewal, here's what to expect during the intake process and how to track your progress.

Step 1: Please begin by filling out Renewal's intake form.

This form will ask you for general demographic info, what you are seeking counseling for, and financial aid information (if applicable).

Step 2: Renewal intake meeting.

Schedule a time to speak with a male or female member of the diaconate on Renewal's PRN Committee in order to discuss a couple of items:

- Introduction to the PRN model
- Identifying a church shepherd
- Financial aid

Step 3: Joint shepherd/diaconate meeting.

After you have identified who your church shepherd will be, a member of the PRN Committee will meet with the two of you to confirm expectations, commitments, and a follow-up plan.

Step 4: Fill out PRN's intake form.

You will have to scroll to the very bottom of the page where it says "Connect with a Counselor".

If you submitted PRN's intake form before Renewal's, the PRN patient care coordinator will reach out to involve Renewal diaconate in your care. If you haven't heard from us, it means we haven't received any communication from them. To ensure Renewal support, fill out our form or contact the diaconate at diaconate.prn@gmail.com.

Step 5: Complete intake with PRN.

PRN's patient care coordinator will contact you to connect you with a counselor and guide you through completing additional forms, including:
